

# Paper Roll Relief Sculptures

## STEPS TO FOLLOW:

1. You will make several quick thumbnail sketches of different, ABSTRACT ideas for your relief sculptures in your sketchbooks.
2. You will receive toilet paper and paper towel rolls to begin creating your relief sculpture. You will use glue to adhere the pieces together.
3. You will choose which color to paint your relief sculpture – think mixed colors (ex: turquoise blue, hunter green), not colors straight out of the bottle.
4. You will paint your relief sculpture.
5. You will grade yourself on your rubric, attach to the back of your project with a paper clip, and turn it in.
