- You will choose which color to paint your relief sculpture – think mixed colors (ex: turquoise blue, hunter green), not colors straight out of the bottle.
- 4. You will paint your relief sculpture.
- 5. You will grade yourself on your rubric, attach to the back of your project with a paper clip, and turn it in.
